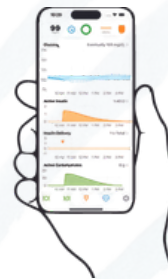

Mobi for Loop, Trio and AAPS is next.

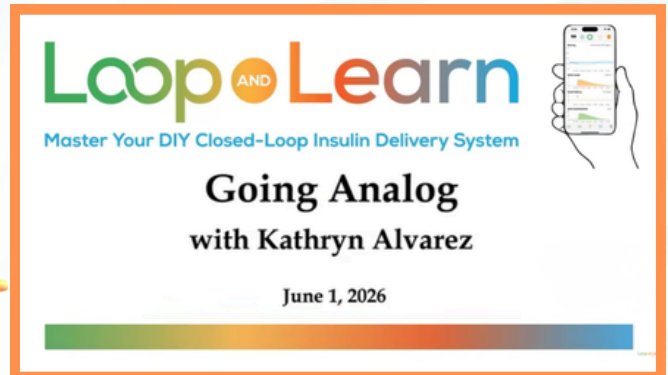

WWDC: Take Note

Apple's Worldwide Developer (WWDC) conference is next week (June 8-12).

- 1) It's free to [watch online](#).
- 2) This is a great time for all of us to take a minute to [make sure](#) that automatic iOS updates on our phone are disabled and that we don't allow beta iOS. iOS 27 is likely to be announced and loopers should always steer clear of beta and give the devs some time to make sure that there are no glitches that impact your open source AID.
- 3) This weekend will be a good time to make sure that all of your apps will survive through next week without an update. In prior years, Apple's servers have had some downtime during the WWDC and while any downtime may only last a few hours, it's just not worth the risk.
- 4) We're likely to see a new Apple dev program license agreement that will need to be signed.

A Unified Approach to OS-AID Development

As a result of last year's Hack, the idea emerged for a workstream focused on collaboration among developers of OS-AID across phone and app boundaries, including how each interfaces with Nightscout, and now, Nocturne. In late January, that idea became a reality when Loop and Learn began hosting regular meetings, bringing together developers to share a common space and maintain productive, ongoing discussions. This includes developers working with Trio, AAPS, Loop, OpenAPS, Nightscout, and Nocturne. We are already finding that this new co-working arrangement is good for the developer community and for the development process as a whole!
